Society of St. Vincent de Paul– 5K Walk/Run Began in 2008 to celebrate the 175th anniversary of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul one of the oldest and most effective charitable organizations in the world. Monies raised are applied to a wide range of assistance to the needy and those living in poverty, including: rent, transportation, (TAPS passes) and utility costs. All proceeds directly benefit people in the Wylie community and there are no administrative fees associated with the event. Each community's walk is organized and run by its own SVDP Conference or Council. The 2013 Walk was held at more than 220 locations around the country, and attracted more than 22,000 participants, and raised more than \$2.1 million. Walkers are encouraged to make a personal monetary donation as well as collect pledges from supporters.
