The Finance Council joins our Pastor, Father Andrew Semler, in thanking you for your continued support of St. Anthony's Parish community. Catholic charity has been summed up as the Love of God, in which we are able to participate. It is truly amazing to see the continued growth of the parish not only in number, but in the participation and giving of each one's time, talents, and treasures. We are truly a blessed community built on a strong faith foundation. It is through everyone's cooperation that we have been able to have another great 2014 fiscal year. Highlights of the financial operations of the Parish for the twelve month period ended on June 30, 2014 include the following:

- We were able to complete and begin use of our new parking lot to accommodate the continuously growing mass attendance.

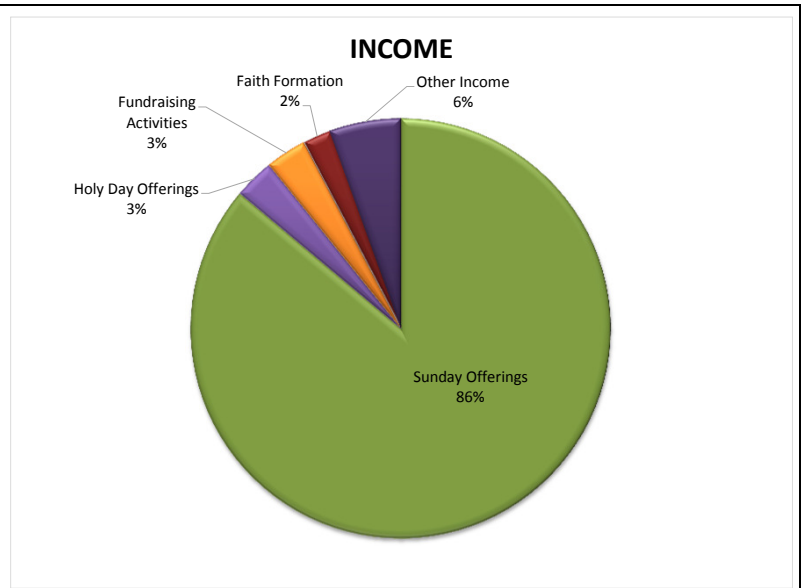

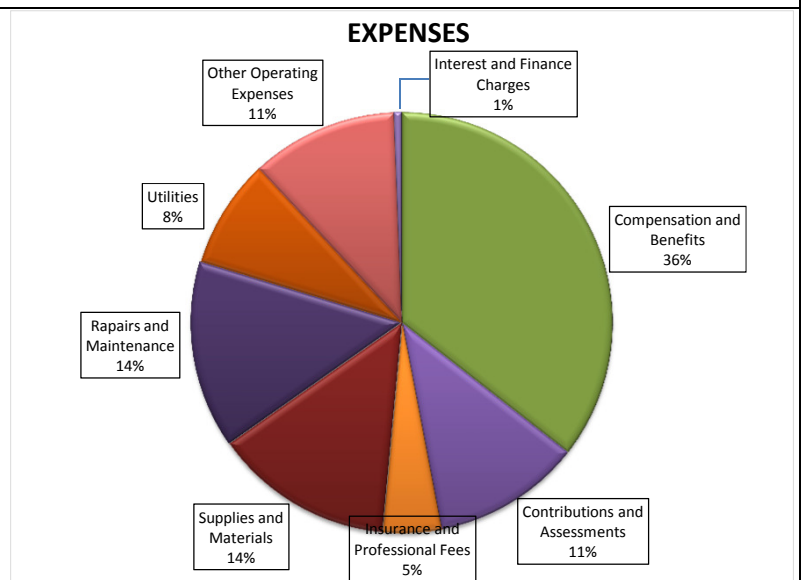
