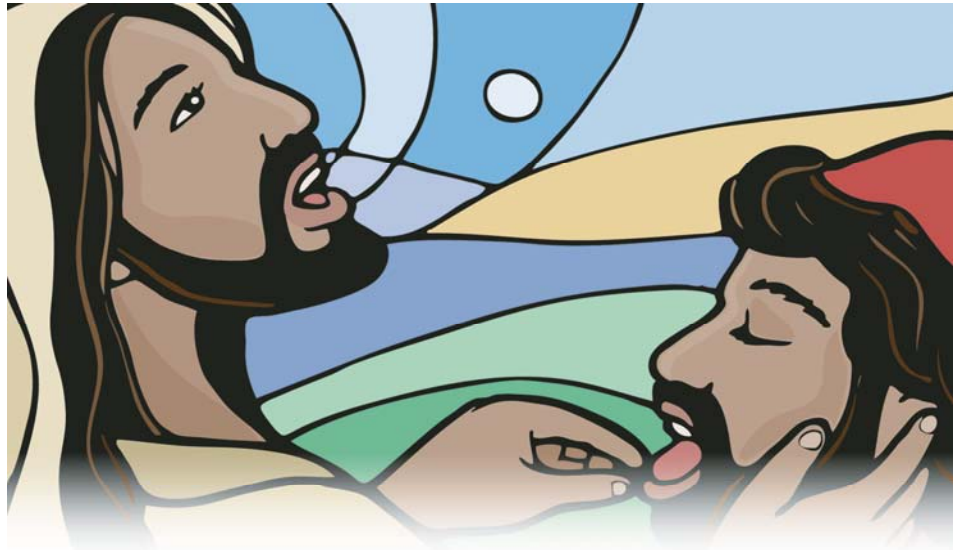

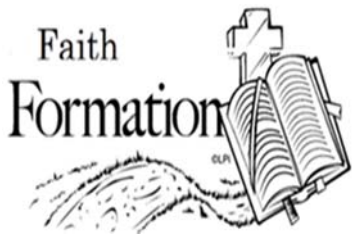
### Monthly Mass for Catholics in Recovery – Sept 12<sup>th</sup>
