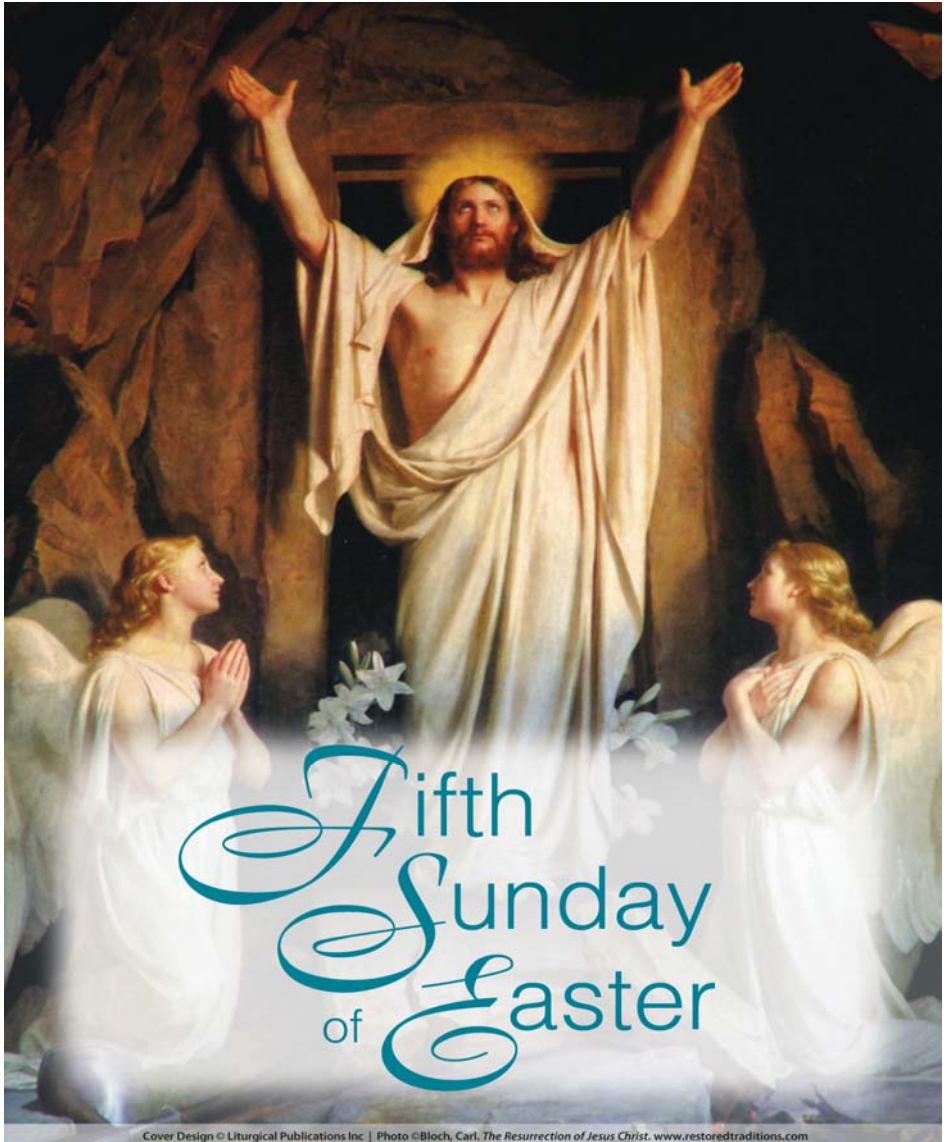

GROUP QUINCE AÑOS

The traditional Quinceañera Mass will be celebrated three (3) times a year as a group. The family must be registered members at St. Anthony and contact the parish office one (1) year prior to the celebration to schedule a meeting with the Quinceañera consultant to determine if the young lady has fulfilled the requirements to celebrate the traditional Mass. **No Quinceañera celebration during Lent and Advent.**

Requirements: 1) The Quinceañera must be registered and attending Faith Formation classes at Saint Anthony two years prior to the celebration. 2) The Quinceañera must be Confirmed or in their second year of Faith Formation preparing to receive Confirmation.
