St. Anthony's Building Fund

Over the past several years there has been some confusion on the **Building Fund** for St. Anthony. What is the Building Fund? What are we using the money for? (e.g. The "New" building. The Church. The campus. Etc.) Is it the same as the Capital Campaign?

To **clarify** for **All donors of the Building Fund (the yellow envelopes)** These offerings are deposited in a money market account at Inwood National Bank and are NOT part of the Capital Campaign. The Capital Campaign and those dollars are held at the Catholic Foundation. The Building Fund envelopes and any donations made to that account are used to maintain the Church Campus Buildings (Church, office, rectory, etc.). These funds will cover emergency replacement/repair of equipment and can be used for extraordinary circumstances when necessary. Ordinary maintenance is covered in our annual budget. If there are any further questions or concerns about this account please feel free to contact any Finance Council member, Father Tony, and/or the Parish Bookkeeper. Thank you.
